

3 components

Background info. about the topic
Show the importance of the study
Introduce the study

1. Background Info.

- Move from general to specific ideas.
- Give historical info., appropriate facts, define terms, review previous research.

2. Establishing the importance of your studyOne of the following:

- Show the research gap
- Raise a question about previous research
- Propose an extension of previous research

3. Introducing the Study

- Objective statement
- Outline the scope
- Explain the **significance**
