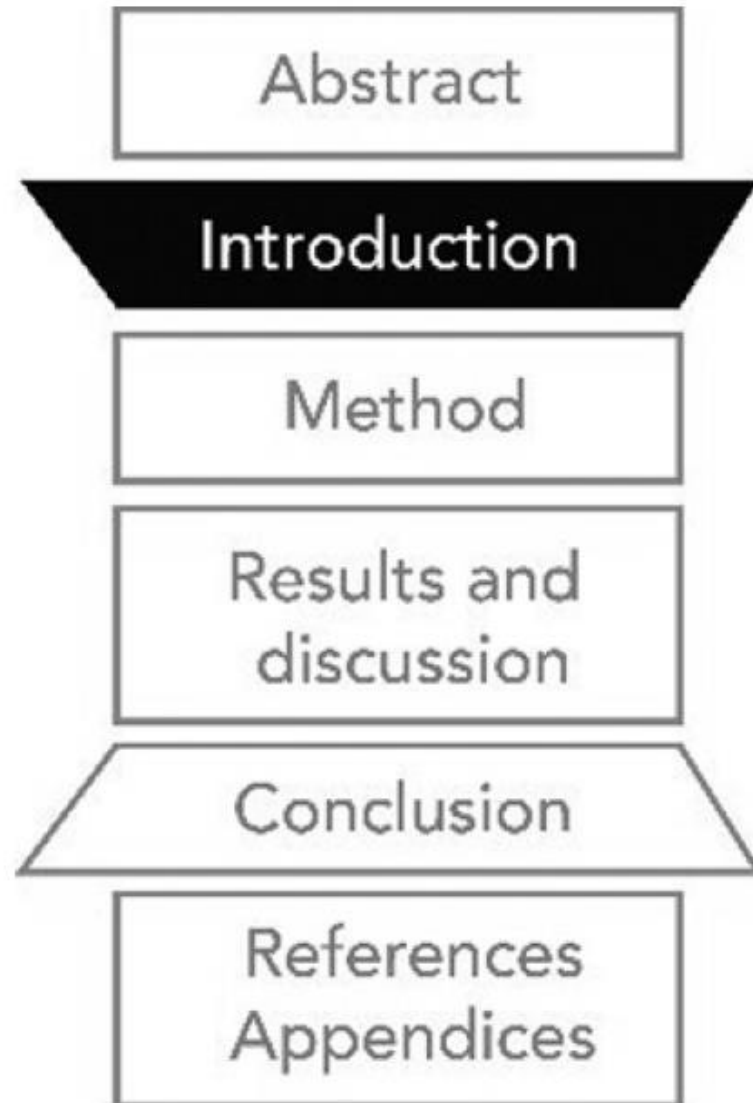


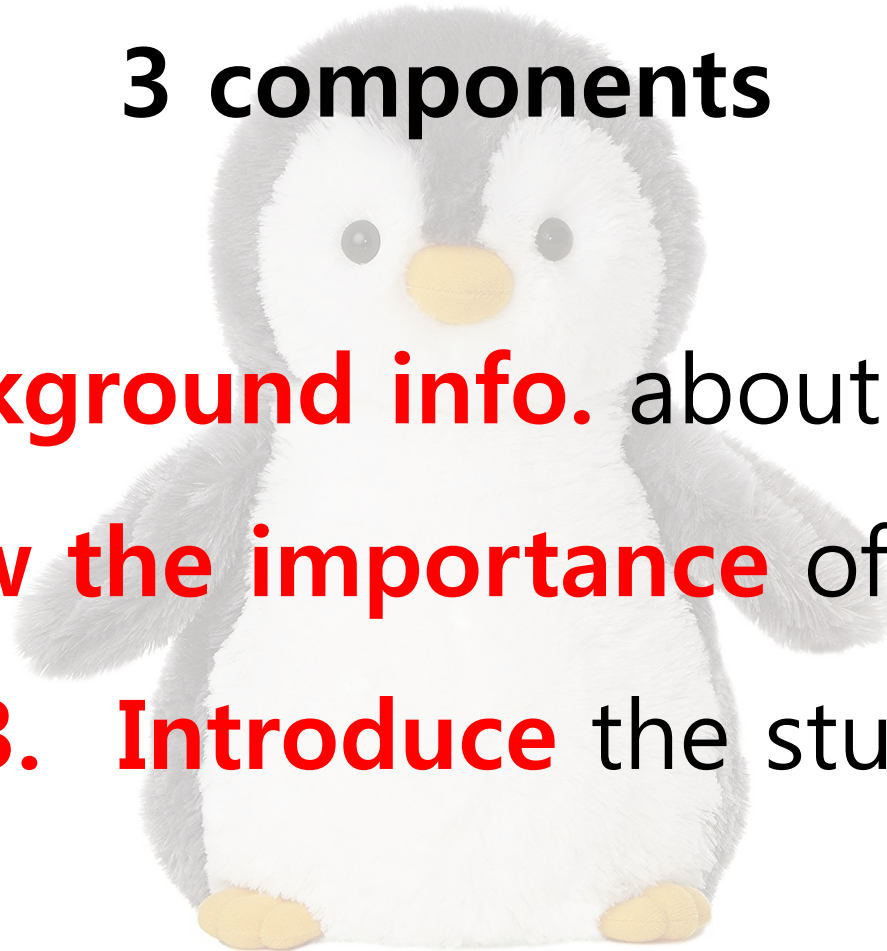
The structure of a research report




The Introduction

3 components

1. **Background info.** about the topic
2. **Show the importance** of the study
3. **Introduce** the study



1. Background Info.

- 
- Move from **general** to **specific** ideas.
 - Give **historical info.**, **appropriate facts**, **define terms**, **review previous research**.

Read the example of component 1

Identify the key features

2. Establishing the importance of your study

One of the following:

- Show the **research gap**
- Raise a **question about previous research**
- Propose an **extension of previous research**

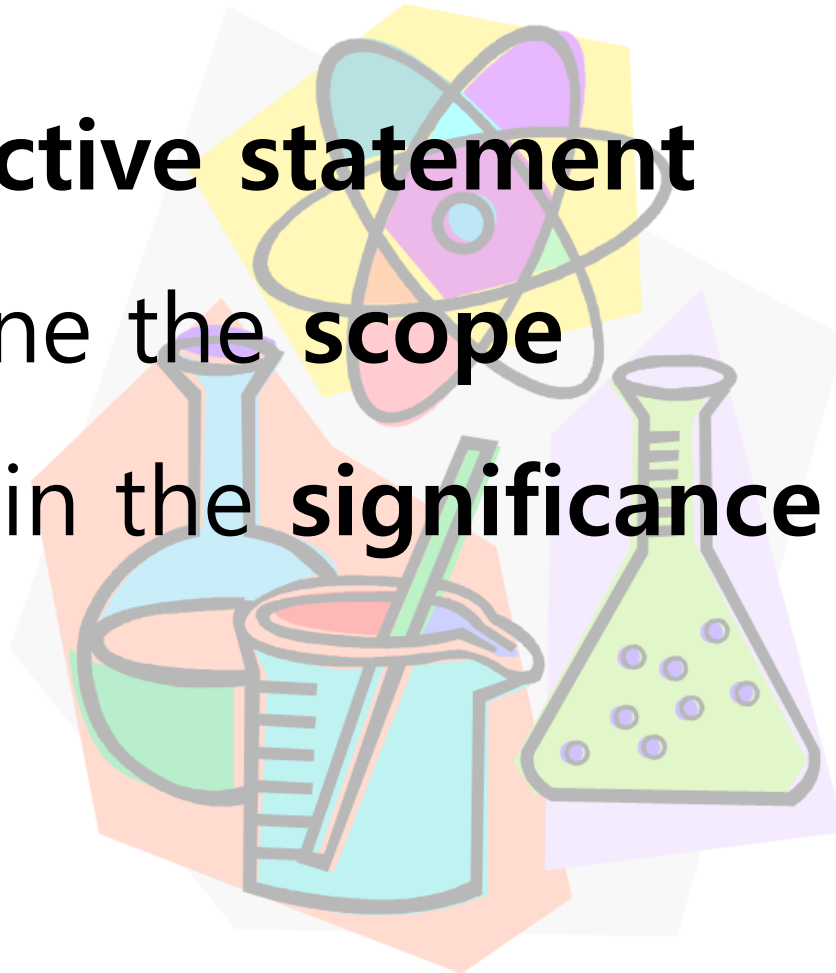


Read the example of component 2

3. Introducing the Study

- **Objective statement**
- Outline the **scope**
- Explain the **significance**
